

KEY TO A.A. CODES

PLEASE NOTE: ALL MEETINGS ARE NON-SMOKING

B. - **BIG BOOK MEETING**: A meeting which is formatted to study the book entitled Alcoholics Anonymous, the basic text of A.A., often called the "Big Book".

C. - **CLOSED MEETING**: Only for persons who qualify for A.A. membership. A.A. makes no determination as to who does or does not qualify for membership. When considering attending closed meetings, you are asked to apply A.A.'s Third Tradition, which states: "The only requirement for membership is a desire to stop drinking."

D. - **DISCUSSION MEETING**: These meetings are organized as general topic discussions on issues pertaining to alcoholism and staying sober.

H. - **HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBLE**

O. - **OPEN MEETING**: Anyone interested in the subject of alcoholism and how to stop drinking may attend.

S. - **SPEAKER MEETING**: Usually consists of a member selected beforehand who tells their story of what it was like, what happened, and what it is like now.

T. - **TWELVE STEP STUDY MEETING**: A meeting dedicated to studying those parts of the "Big Book" that will gain a more thorough understanding of A.A.'s Twelve Steps.

W. - **WOMEN'S MEETING**

12 - **TWELVE & TWELVE MEETING**: A meeting which is formatted to study the book entitled, Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions, a book written by one of our co-founders to further explain the process of recovery from alcoholism through Alcoholics Anonymous.
